Undergraduate Programme

B.ASLP Bachelor in Audiology Speech-Language Pathology

- Four year course, divided into six semesters, with one year compulsory internship. B.ASLP is approved by the Rehabilitation Council of India.
- The course is a totally job oriented hospital based professional course which provides high openings in the area of health care industry.
- As there is a shortage of professionals in the field, there is a great demand and scope for the programme.
- Audiology is the scientific study of hearing, balance and disorders. Audiologists

evaluate, diagnose and manage hearing loss and balance disorders and fit hearing aids.

Speech-Language Pathology is the scientific study of speech, language development, and their disorders in children and adults and also study swallowing difficulties. They are also called Speech Therapists. This profession involves the evaluation, diagnosis and management of all speech, Language, voice, and swallowing disorders

Eligibility

A pass in 10+2 or an equivalent examination from a recognized board with a minimum of 50% in aggregate.The candidate should have studied Physics, Chemistry and any one of the following Subjects: Biology / Mathematics / Computer Science / Statistics / Electronics / Psychology.

Audiometer

Advanced PC-based Audiometer which assesses the hearing acuity at different frequencies and hearing levels



Vestibular Assessment

Equipment to evaluate concerns related to balance



Auditory Brainstem Response (ABR)

State-of-the-art equipment to assess the functioning of the inner ear, auditory nerve, and higher structures in newborn babies, children and adults

Immittance meter

Hitech middle ear analyzer capable of performing tympanometry, Reflexometry, and other special tests

Oto Acoustic Emission-OAE

A vital test to assess hearing acuity in new-borns and adults



REM and EAC

Reliable method to assess the real ear performance of the hearing instrument and check if they meet the industry standards

Speech Language Pathology

- Electroglottogram (EGG) is a non-invasive technique used for assessing the Vocal Fold vibratory patterns
- Nasal View is a non-invasive technique used to assess the amount of nasality in our Speech
- Spirometry is a non-invasive technique used to assess the respiratory capacity required for speech
- Stroboscopy is an invasive technique for visualization of Vocal fold movements.
- In Speech Language Diagnostic unit, adequacy of Speech and Language abilities of clients are assessed.
- A Speech Language Pathologist (SLP) is a person who assesses and treats people with Communication Disorders.

Postgraduate Programme

Master of Science (Audiology)

- Two years course, divided into four semesters. M.Sc. (Audiology) is approved by the Rehabilitation Council of India and Govt. of Puducherry.
- The course is a totally job oriented hospital based professional course. This course equips the students with the knowledge to function as researchers, teachers in institutions of higher learning. The course moulds the students with talents to become highly professional practitioner.



Master of Science (Speech-Language Pathology)

- Two years course, divided into four semesters. MSc (Speech – Language Pathology) is approved by the Rehabilitation Council of India and Govt. of Puducherry.
- The course is a totally job oriented hospital based professional course.
- This course equips the students with the knowledge to function as researchers, teachers in institutions of higher learning.

Eligibility for M.Sc.(Aud) & M.Sc.(SLP)

Candidates with B. ASLP / B.Sc. (Speech & Hearing) degree from any recognized University by the Rehabilitation Council of India with a minimum of 55% in aggregate are eligible for admission to the programme.



Master of Science (Clinical Psychology)

- The field of Clinical Psychology focuses on the scientific study of human behavior and its application to mental health.
- This program provides academic coursework and clinical training, and supervisions that prepare graduate students for careers in the mental health field.

Eligibility :

Degree in B.A. / B.Sc in Psychology / Applied Psychology / Counselling Psychology / Clinical Psychology with at least 50% marks in aggregate from any recognized University in India or abroad recognized by UGC / AIU.

Eligibility for P.G.D.E.I

Candidates who have passed M.B.B.S./ BAMS / BUMS / BSMS / BNYS or Equivalent Degree, BOT / BPT / BASLP / B.Ed-SE / or Equivalent Degree, B.Sc Nursing, Post Graduate in Psychology / Social Work / Special Education / Child Development or Equivalent Degree, 50% aggregate marks in the qualifying examinations.

Post Graduate Diploma In Early Intervention (P.G.D.E.I)

- Post Graduate Diploma in Early Intervention is offered by the Department of Speech Language pathology.
- This one year program trains students in early childhood education by providing a comprehensive education that promotes the holistic growth and development of young children.

scope of P.G.D.E.I program

Upon completion of the course, the professionals have a scope of working in pediatric units of hospitals, pediatric clinics, child guidance clinics, risk follow-up clinics, child development centers, and rural primary health centers in district health centers.



Master of Philosophy (Clinical Psychology)

Eligibility : Minimum educational requirement for admission to this course is 2 years M.A. / M.Sc. degree (Psychology, Applied Psychology, Counselling Psychology, Clinical Psychology) in full time regular mode from a university recognized by the UGC with a minimum of 55% marks in aggregate. For SC/ST category & PwD, minimum of 50% marks in aggregate is essential, as per GOI.

- The Department of Clinical Psychology provides two-year program with extensive theoretical inputs and widespread clinical experience to acquire the necessary skills in the area of Clinical Psychology.
- Clinical Psychologists apply knowledge and methods from all substantive fields of biopsychosocial sciences for the promotion and prevention, diagnosis, treatment, and rehabilitation of mental and physical disorders / problems where psychological factors play a major role.
