Name of LD	Challenge	Example Problems in School
Dyslexia	Reading	Problems reading, writing, spelling, speaking, fine motor, memorizing, understanding time, and focus
Dysgraphia	Handwriting and written word organization	Hard to write, make letters stay on line, and space letters. Often prints. Hard to organize ideas and spell.
Dyscalculia	Math	Problems understanding and using symbols, number sense, math problems, time, and money.
Auditory Processing Disorder	Understanding & Responding	Language (hearing, understanding, and speaking), reading, and comprehension.
ADHD	Focus &	Problems focusing, & with impulsiveness, hyperactivity, or

T I P S F O R L D

- keep things in perspective. A learning disability isn't insurmountable.
 - Become your own expert.
 - Be an advocate for your child.
- Remember that you influence outweigh all others.
 - Offer new solution.
 - Don't give up easily.
- Identify how your child learns best (visual learner/auditory learner).
 - *Think life success rather than school success.*

 - Help with grammar, punctuation, syntax, spelling, calculation
