The Department of Clinical Psychology, SRBS has successfully organized a two-day workshop titled “Psychological Assessment and Its Role in Court, and Psychological Interventions for Pseudo Seizures,” held on 19/02/2025 & 20/02/2025, at the Smt. Annapurani Mini Auditorium, AVMC. Prof. K. Vijayan, Former Professor of Clinical Psychology, IMH was the resource person, with Prof. N.D. Rajan, Advisor & Consultant, SRBS leading the event and Dr. Arun Banik, Director SRBS delivered the felicitation.

Dr. E. Sambandam, Head of the Clinical Psychology Department, presided over the event. The workshop’s coordination was meticulously managed by team of assistant professors, including Mrs. Aruna Kumari G, Mr. Ajeethkumar R, Ms. Divya Barathi TM, Mr. Manu Jose, and Dr. Sivakumar V.

Day 1, participants delved into Psychological Assessments and role of Court, learning about the critical role of psychological evaluations in legal settings. Prof. Vijayan led discussions on case studies, legal precedents, and practical tools that psychologists can use when working with the legal system.



Day 2 focused on Psychological Intervention for Pseudo-Seizures, where participants explored various diagnostic methods and interventions used to treat non-epileptic seizures caused by psychological factors. Through interactive activities and therapeutic workshops, attendees gained knowledge in applying techniques such as Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT) and stress management strategies.
